1. Chair welcomes the members

Chris Axon noted that the CLT now has 63 members, and over the last year members and other volunteers have put in over 1,000 hours of time.

4. Update on The Lawns project

Robert Shaw (Director, and Chair of the Project Board) gave a presentation updating our project on The Lawns, including:

- Progress in securing the site with a 250 year lease for £1
- Support and funding provided by CLH London and our ward councillors;
- Set-up work completed for us by Chris Carthy, a Project Coordinator we appointed over the past year.
- The appointment of a Project Manager from Brick by Brick to pick up from Chris Carthy; our architects, Archio; and our solicitors, Anthony Collins LLP.
- How far we have got with the design work, with our 12-strong Resident Design Group that joined our Project Board to work with the architects on this.

Members discussed feedback from, and engagement with, neighbouring residents on The Lawns and Beauchamp Road and how we can continue to engage them.

5. Resolution to dis-apply the requirement for an audit for 2020-21

Members agreed the following resolution:
